MoMM2003 consists of a peer-reviewed technical program, short papers and posters, demos, tutorials, panels, invited sessions on the same or related topics, industrial track, and exhibitions.

RESEARCH AND TECHNICAL TRACK

Authors are requested to register the abstract of their papers by June 1, 2003 and to submit the full paper electronically before June 15, 2003. For paper registration and electronic submission please use the conference website.

The length of a paper should not exceed 12 pages. The paper must be formatted in A4 with Times fonts of size 11. The printing area should be 14.66 x 24.62cm. Submissions should be in PDF or MS Word format.

Submitted papers will be carefully evaluated based on originality, significance, technical soundness, and clarity of exposition. All accepted conference papers by an international publisher with ISBN. Selected papers will be publisher as a special issue of the International Journal of Mobile Communication.

INDUSTRIAL TRACK

Industrial presentations will describe current challenges and trends of the mobile multimedia industry. Nominations for topics and speakers are welcome, and should be submitted electronically by July 1, 2003.

TUTORIALS

Proposals are invited for high-quality half-day tutorials. Proposals should include a two-page description and motivation for the topic of the tutorial, the full name and address of the tutorial speaker(s), a concise description of the contents and goals of the tutorial with a few keywords for each section, a rough estimate of the time spent on each section, the level of the tutorial, the required audience experience, and the speaker(s) biography. Tutorial proposals should be submitted by June 1, 2003. The program committee will give notification of acceptance by July 2003.
