# More than 40 countries join IIWAS 2006 in Yogyakarta

**Yogyakarta (ANTARA News)** - Some 100 speakers from 40 countries will present working papers in the 8th international conference on Information Integration and Web-based Application & Services 2006 (IIWAS 2006) being held at the Atma Jaya University campus here from December 4 to 6.

The conference was opened by head of the Provincial Information Agency Prof Dr. Ahmad Junaedi instead of the Communication and Information Affairs Minister Sofyan Jalil and Yogyakarta Governor Sri Sultan Hamengkubuwono X, who both of them failed to show up.

IIWAS president Dr Ismail Khalil Ibrahim from Johannes Kepler University Liz, Austria, who was accompanied by rector of Atma Jaya University Dr. Slamet S. Sarwono said the international conference consisted of the 8th IIWAS2006 and the 4th Mobile Computing and Multimedia (MoMM2006).

"This IIWAS2006 conference is aimed at giving an opportunity to industrial researchers and practitioners to share fresh ideas, results of original research and experiences on information integration, application and web-based services and other related issues," he said.

Meanwhile, the MoMM2006 is an international conference designed to provide an opportunity to researchers, students and professionals to share their experiences on latest developments in wireless technology for mobile and multimedia computing services.

In addition, other activities which will follow the conference consist of workshop relating to Sematic Information Integration on Knowledge Discovery (SIK2006), International Workshop on Mobile Multimedia Information Retrieval (MoMIR2006), Broadband and Wireless Computing, Communication and Application (BWCAA2006), International Workshop on Systems-On-Chips (SoC-06) and International Workshop on Trustworthy Ubiquitous Computing (TwUC-06).

A number of local and overseas keynote speakers will also present the working papers on multimedia and information technology during the conference. (\*)
